Have you been on a mission trip? What did you like most about it?

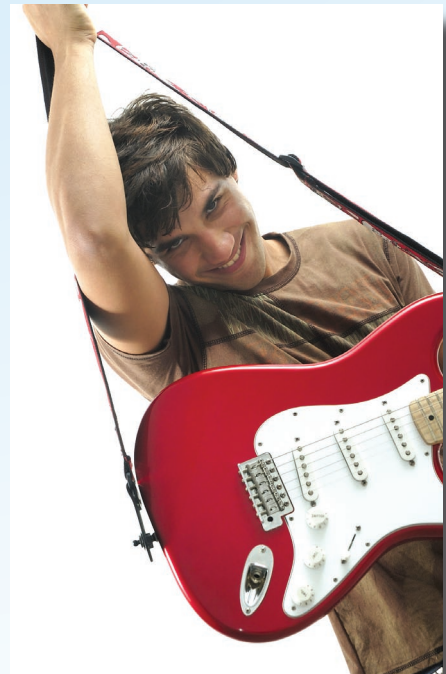
I went to New York City and I loved the fellowship with other students and leaders.
