On Nov. 17, at The Gardens Mall, guests and supporters enjoyed a holiday-inspired trunk show of outfits and gift-giving ideas, while giving back to the nonprofit children's organization. Committee members confirmed 40 corporate and family sponsors for the Bash but they are actively seeking more supporters, in order to assist more foster children.

Held at PGA National Resort & Spa, Hope Bash will feature a live and silent auction, dinner and dancing, and a special Bid from the Heart. New for 2017, Hope Bash will have a Giving Tree, a real tree adorned with children's wishes that guests can grant for as little as \$25 to \$100. The tree will also be included in the live auction and planted on campus for the kids to enjoy.

"We want to give everyone an opportunity to help a child, whether it's underwriting a birthday cake or buying a bicycle," said Havlicek. "The Giving Tree will be a part of the Bash's silent auction, and then featured as part of the evening's program."
